CHARACTERISTICS

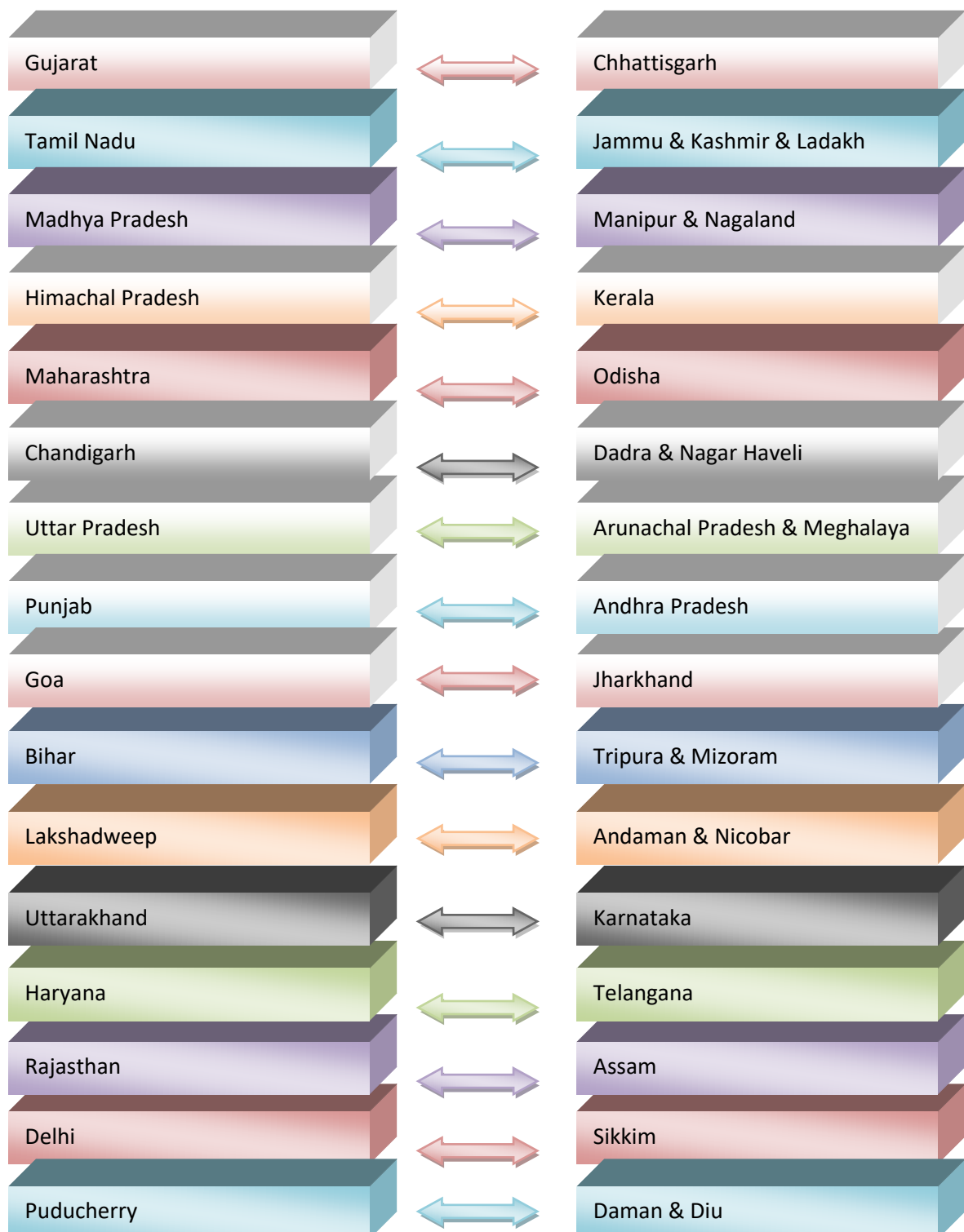
- It is a booster initiative for national integration and reduces geographical distances among people.
